### TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. Teams will consist of two female bowlers. All bowlers must be currently sanctioned as an Adult Member of USBC. If not sanctioned in Bergen County USBC, you must pay a \$15.00 out of county fee (no out of state checks are allowed).
- 2. This is a Scratch & Handicap Tournament. Handicaps will be on: Doubles basis: 100% of 440 & Singles basis: 100% of 220. There is no maximum Handicap for either Event.
  - a. All Doubles that enter over 440 will be entered in the Scratch Division Only.
  - b. All Singles that enter over 220 will be entered in the Scratch Division Only.
  - c. Prize money will be divided as follows: 40% Scratch and 60% Handicap-FOR BOTH EVENTS
- 3. Bowlers must use their highest certified sanctioned average. Please note that Sport averages will be recalculated to Standard averages. Each bowler must use an entering average in the following manner with a minimum of 21 games:
  - a. 2023-2024 Highest USBC Certified Average.
  - b. 2022–2023 Highest USBC Certified Average.
  - c. If the bowler does not have a USBC Certified Average from the past two seasons but bowls in a current USBC Sanctioned league, the highest average as of the day of bowling will be used (minimum 21 game rule still applies). The bowler must bring in their league's most current standing sheet for average verification. If a standing sheet cannot be produced the bowler will bowl following rule 3(d).
  - d. Bowlers with no averages that qualify will use an average of 230.
  - e. Youth averages are not valid for this Tournament.
- 4. Bowlers may re-enter the tournament according to the following rules:
  - a. Doubles: No bowler may cash more than once with the same partner.
  - b. Singles: A bowler may re-enter a maximum of Three (3) times. No bowler may cash more than once.
- 5. Bowlers must report 30 minutes before their scheduled squad time to have their credentials verified and receive lane assignments.
- 6. If there is a tie for First Place, Co-Champions will be declared, and prize monies will be shared.
- 7. Errors in scoring must be reported to the Tournament Secretary within 24 hours.
- 8. It is the bowler's responsibility to comply with USBC Rule 319d, USBC Rule 319a-3, 4, 5, and USBC Rule 319c-1.
- 9. USBC Rule 319e (Average Adjustment) applies to all entrants.
- 10. No entry will be accepted without the full entry fee of \$100.00 per team or \$50.00 per single.
- 11. Proper bowling attire must be worn during the tournament. Bowlers must be dressed in a neat and presentable manner. (i.e., no torn shorts, pants, or shirts).
- 12. Lane conditions will be a house shot.
- 13. USBC Tournament Rules apply.
- 14. The Tournament Committee reserves all rights.
